"Going Deeper in Prayer" Fr. Jerry Byrd

Prayer is an essential part of the Christian life, but also something that can easily become routine or be taken for granted. In this Retreat, Fr. Byrd will explore the "why's", "when's", "where's", "how's", and "what's" of learning to go deeper with our prayer, so that it can be more meaningful and fruitful for our spiritual lives. The titles of the five retreat conferences will be: 1. Prayer requires commitment (Why should I pray?) 2. Prayer requires time (When should I pray?) 3. Prayer requires a place (Where should I pray?) 4. Prayer requires a style (How Should I pray?) 5. Prayer requires diligence (What about distractions?)

Fr. Jerry Byrd is a priest of the Archdiocese of Indianapolis. He is the pastor of St. Ann, St. Joseph, and St. Mary parishes in Jennings County. He was ordained to the priesthood on June 2, 2012. Father Byrd grew up in the Southern Baptist church, and became Catholic when he was a teenager.
