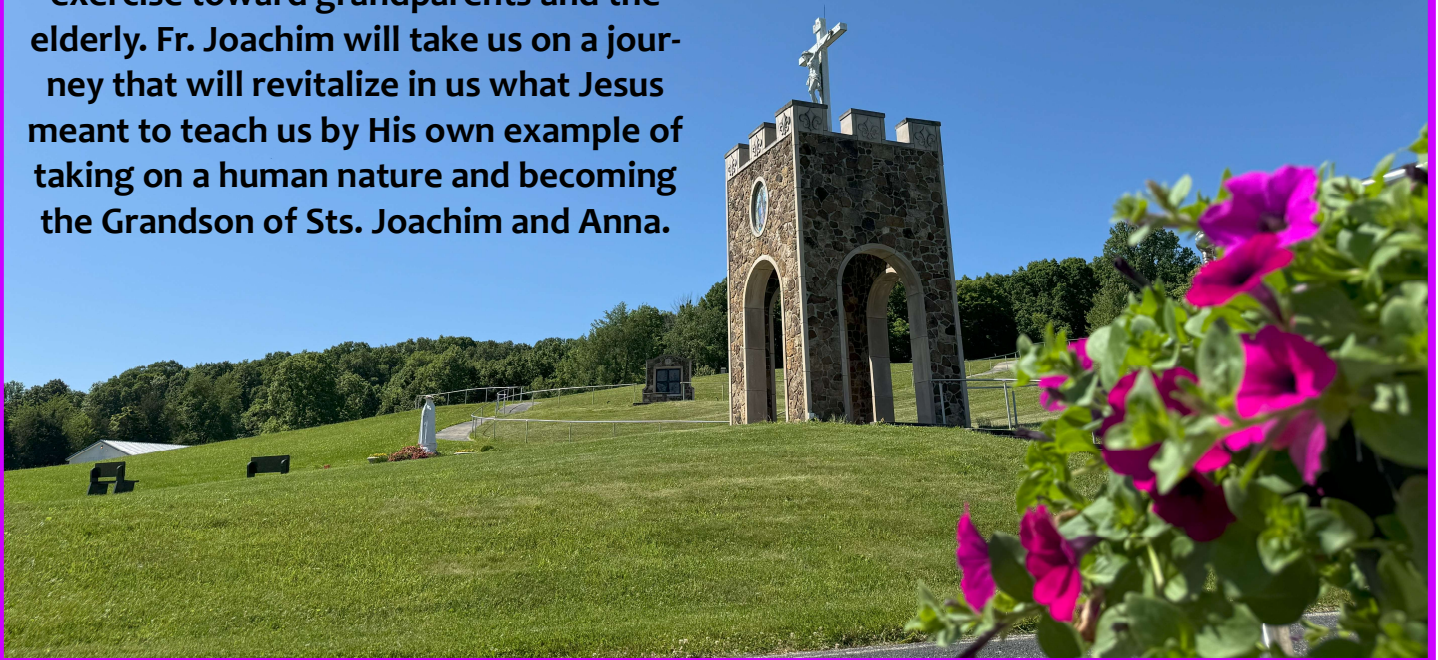
“Honoring the Elderly & Grand Parenting in Scripture”
