Message of October 5, 1993, from Our Lord Jesus

Ruth Ann: Jesus.

Jesus: Yes, little one.

Ruth Ann: I wish to thank You, Lord, for making it possible for us to go to the Marian Conference in Chicago. It was just what Jim and I needed. It was so good to hear others say all of the things that ring true in our hearts. It was also good to hear others were, and are, just as reluctant to do Your will.

Jesus: Child, I am pleased that you have given thanks for something most of My children would, and do, take for granted; and I am glad that the words spoken by others have given you comfort.

Ruth Ann: Lord, I'd like to be able to do all that You wish with a joyful heart. Why is it so difficult?

Jesus: It is because you must live in a world that is totally covered in darkness, little one. The evil one and his cohorts try to make life as difficult as possible for those that God has chosen. You don't think for one moment he is going to give up without a fight, do you? He is the prince of darkness. He is a liar, and his destructive ways are evident upon the earth in great force.

You say it is difficult to do My will, that is because you are concerned about what others would say or will do. Your main concern should be what God will say, and what God will do. Your time on the earth is but a blink of an eye, your time

spent with Me is forever. That should put all you say and do here on the earth in proper perspective. I said, 'should', child. I know that it is difficult to step out in faith. I know it is difficult to give up your life, home, and peace of mind. I have walked that road, remember? It is a long and difficult path to Calvary; but to receive your eternal reward, one must pick up his cross and follow Me. The world and all that it stands for must be put behind you.

Ruth Ann: I know what You are saying, Lord, and most days I am able to cope with all things. It's just that sometimes Jim and I get the feeling of being overwhelmed. With Your help, and that of Your Mother, I know we'll be fine. I guess that is why I was so

appreciative of hearing so many 'important' people say they had felt the same way. The theme of the conference, "You Did Not Choose Me, No I Have Chosen You," kept echoing over and over in my heart. Many times Jim and I have said that we would never have chosen to do this, never in a million years. No, we had planned on working, teaching that is, and then retiring, and traveling, living a life of quiet with our family. We can see that this will never be.

Jesus: Child, it was never meant to be. I would have more of My children helping Me if they would only listen and say 'yes' to what I have chosen for them. Darkness gets in the way. They turn and walk away, when they find what I want for them is too difficult. It is easier for them to walk away and say, "This is not of God. He would not want me to suffer so." Did I not suffer? Did I not struggle? Was I not tempted by the evil one? Did My human nature not come through at times on My difficult journey to do My Father's will? The Way of the Cross is symbolic of the many times that My children will fall and be tempted to not go forward in the difficult journey ahead of them. I fell three times on the way to Calvary. My children will fall many, many times until their journey is complete.

You are correct in connecting your burden with those of others I have chosen. You are beginning to see what lies ahead, little one. It will continue to get more and more difficult, but do not be discouraged. Do not lose hope. I am with you and so is My Mother. The graces you

and your family will need to carry this heavy burden will be made available to you as you need them. The importance of what you are doing for others far outweighs the inconvenience that is being caused in your life. You are not to worry. That is not of Me. Put all in My hands. I will tend to your most basic needs, as well as those which you consider great.

Life is a journey of faith, child. I know you have heard your priest say that many times. No one is perfect. It is through that journey of faith and trust in God that you, as well as all My children, become all I wish them to become, by accepting God's will and going forward at all cost. That is what one must do, and in order to do that, you must confess your sins, be sorry for them, and receive absolution on a regular basis. You must receive the Eucharist as often as possible. These will provide you with the strength and grace to carry on.

Ruth Ann: Lord, many are receiving miracles on the farm. I am pleased for this. Thanks to You and Your Mother, many hearts are being touched. So many of us are in need Lord, of miracles, in order to believe. So again, I thank You for the graces You are giving others here.

Jesus: And I thank you for saying, 'yes.' Had you not said 'yes', these graces and miracles would not be available to so many.

Ruth Ann: Lord, You always give me more credit than I deserve.

Jesus: I have so few willing to help Me and My Mother, child. Your love and consideration for others is truly a blessing for Us both. Without it, many would still be floundering around in the darkness of the world. You have provided a beacon of light. You have blessed Us by allowing Us to use your

farm, for the greater honor and glory of God.

Ruth Ann: I guess I don't see how I can be a blessing to You or Your Mother, Lord. I have heard You say this before, and the concept goes over my head. I think in terms of Your blessing us, or the priest blessing us. I don't think and don't understand the concept of us blessing You, but if You say so, I believe.

Jesus: (replied with a smile in His voice) Child, in your faith, you are such a blessing. How it touches My heart for you to say, "I love You so much," or "If You say so, I believe You, Lord," and "I will really try to do all You ask of me, Lord. Just don't give up on me and my reluctance to do what You wish for me to do." Little one, the fact that you want to do My will and that of My Father give you graces beyond belief.

Ruth Ann: Then why do I feel sometimes like I'd like to walk away from all this and be a normal person, Lord?

Jesus: That is not coming from the side of light, peace, and hope. That is when you need Me and the graces of My Mother the most. The one of darkness continues to thwart all the good that is, and will come, as a result of the goodness and kindness of your heart, and those who are of help to you in any way. God sees and hears all, little one. Not one thing goes unnoticed. Those who are of help to you and do little kindnesses for you will receive blessings, and those who do you harm, too, are being watched carefully. Those who would do harm to the least of My little ones, they do this unto Me. My Father will, and is not, pleased with those who slander and find fault with those who give up so much for the sake of others.

Ruth Ann: Could we please end on a good note, Lord? I really don't care about those who credit me with things I don't say. I just think, how do people get such nonsense in their heads? One day, someone called about a message that I had supposedly been given about the world ending at Christmas time. Jim and I laughed, because I had never received such a message; and if I did, I would certainly have been suspicious that it was not of You. You do not give me such as that, and neither does Your Mother.

Jesus: No child, you are only told those things We wish for you to know. No one knows the day, or the hour, for the end of the world. That is why all of My children should always keep their lives in order. No one knows when they will be called upon to meet their Maker. I am pleased that you are able to keep a light heart concerning the things that others will credit to you that are not true, or that have not come from your lips. I am sorry that these are things that will happen, and can only be stopped by those who know the truth. There will be those who wish to discredit you and the words spoken to you; so lies will be made up, when they find that there is nothing that can be found in your messages contrary to Scripture. Do not be disturbed when these things happen. It is all part of the persecution that comes from following the road I walked before you. It is all part of a very heavy cross that is to be part of your journey of faith and trust in God. It's all part of doing God's will. Rejoice, little one. Rejoice, and enjoy this beautiful day created by God.

Ruth Ann: I do, Lord. Thank You for taking time to make a beautiful day even more beautiful. I love You so much, Lord.

Jesus: And I love you, little one. Go in My peace.

*Message of Aug. 30, 1994,
from Our Lord Jesus*

Ruth Ann: Lord, is there anything You wish to share with me today?

Jesus: Child, I am here for you and all My children, at all times. Never feel abandoned. Even in your most difficult of times, I am here.

Ruth Ann: Why do some have greater difficulties than others, Lord? Why is there so much pain in the world?

Jesus: Little one, this was not the intent of My Father. God's intent was that man share in the beauty of the world He had created. Man sinned and caused this division between him and the Lord God, Creator of all things. It is through this division that suffering and trials have come, and continue to come. The farther man chose to get away from God, the greater the trials and suffering. The innocent suffer right along with the guilty in a Godless society.

Ruth Ann: Lord, I hear You, and I understand we brought all this upon ourselves.

Jesus: Right, little one. Man has been warned over and over, and yet he chooses to ignore the signs. The pain and suffering will not stop, child, it will continue.

Ruth Ann: Lord, I'm having a difficult time listening, I'm so easily distracted today.

Jesus: Child, this is a common problem that exists in the minds and hearts of all My children. You are concerned about all you need to get done today, and all you truly need to remember is; what I would have you do today, is listen. That should be your number one priority today. The

rest will fall into place.

Ruth Ann: I'm sorry, Lord. You are exactly right.

Jesus: Be at peace, little one, with your day, and your call to do the will of God. You continue to struggle against all I would have you do. This makes your life even more difficult than it need be. Yes, you have given much of yourself, and this will continue to be even more as time goes on. But child, there comes a peace with doing the will of God that cannot come otherwise. Do not lose this peace by fighting against that which is best for you and those around you. Be at peace, and know God's Hand is upon you and all you do. When your peace is disturbed, know, child, that the evil one is at work. He can use those who are willing to be used, to cause confusion, doubt, fear, and anger. Do any of these things just mentioned sound as though they would come from God?

Ruth Ann: No, Lord.

Jesus: Then remove all remnants of these from your life. Love God with your whole being, and live this love in all you do and say. Be at peace, little one, and know that these struggles you experience are attacks from the evil one. No matter how difficult the journey you are on, peace should reign in your heart. Be at peace with your life, little one. You are missing your teaching, aren't you?

Ruth Ann: Yes Lord, I am.

Jesus: You are also missing your animals, and the structure that was so much a part of your life.

Ruth Ann: Yes Lord, that is true.

Jesus: You wish to go about your life as though you are in charge, and not

God.

Ruth Ann: You make it sound as though I am being cold.

Jesus: That is not My intent, child. I am trying to make a point.

Ruth Ann: Others get up and go about their lives doing other things, Lord.

Jesus: They have not been called to do what you are doing. If they are doing the will of God, no matter what it may be, they should be at peace. You too, should be at peace.

Ruth Ann: Most of the time I am, Lord. It's just that something happened over the weekend that disturbed this peace. I feel much better after having talked with you about that personal situation this morning. I also appreciate the friends You have given to us, as well as all the people you have sent into our lives to help with this ministry.

Lord, if I didn't miss the life I had before, it would not be a sacrifice, would it?

Jesus: This is true, child, but you must also realize, those who sacrifice much, will be given much. All the careers, animals, material things, and freedom in this life, cannot compare with the rewards in the next. So many of My children are so set upon the pleasures of the world, they forget they are to be preparing for their next life while they are on this earth.

All of these things are good, but they are not to consume you. For some, material things become an obsession, so do their careers. Even hobbies can become such an obsession that God is placed in the background. All these things become gods to My children. I am the Lord thy God, and thou shalt

not have other gods before Me. Does this sound familiar to you?

Ruth Ann: Yes Lord, this is one of the Ten Commandments.

Jesus: It is the first commandment of the ten, and for a reason, child. It is the most important, and the one most violated today. In a world of materialism, man has chosen to worship many gods. Where does that leave Me? Barely in the lives of some, and completely out of the lives of others. You are living in a godless society, and only God can change that which has been brought about by the prince of lies, deceit, and destruction.

My Mother is calling out to Her children to change their ways before it is too late to do so, and yet man chooses, in most cases, not to listen. What you are doing is of great help to Me and My Mother. We thank you for listening and responding to this call. Be at peace with all you are called to do. The sacrifices are great, but the rewards are even greater.

Ruth Ann: I do realize this, Lord, but I would not be human if I occasionally did not feel the burden of this cross given to me.

Jesus: The weight you will always feel, but there is also peace in doing God's will. That peace must be felt in carrying this cross. Do not look back, little one. The cross before you, the world behind you, know I am with you through it all.

Ruth Ann: Forgive me, Lord, for struggling against those things You would have me do.

Jesus: Child, it is through your weaknesses and the sharing of your struggles, that many of My children are being saved. They find hope and peace through your willingness to bare

your heart and soul. All in your life is being used to the greater honor and glory of God, even your weakness, as a strength, when used to help others.

Ruth Ann: Thank You for restoring my peace again, Lord.

Jesus: Had you not listened, this peace would not have come. Know all is in God's tender loving care, child. His plan will not be destroyed. Good will triumph over evil.

Now go about your day, know I am with you tending to all things.

Message of July 14, 1994, from Our Lord Jesus

Jesus: My Mother has said to you, “It will all be done for you.” I can deny Her nothing. She is My Mother, and has given Her life and Her Son’s life to God for His use. “Thy will be done,” She has said, and God’s will has, and will continue to be done.

Ruth Ann: Again, Lord, I wish to thank You for all You have done to give us the support that is needed to keep us going.

Jesus: Little one, this place was not chosen by you or anyone else on the earth, to be a haven of peace and prayer. This was the desire of My Mother, so therefore, it too, is My desire. You are merely human, and could not possibly do all that is needed to make this grow as My Mother wishes. This place is holy ground. It is a place to come for special graces and blessings. You could not in your wildest dreams have made it become what it has become. Only through the grace of God has this been allowed. Know that as this grows through word of mouth, and that is called “evangelizing”, little one, so too, will the support that is needed in order for you not be overwhelmed. You need

only be a willing instrument, ready to do the will of God.

Ruth Ann: So long as You provide the graces and all else that is needed, we’ll continue to do all we can to be of help to You.

Jesus: Little one, you say this with such determination, and yet I know how much you are giving up of your earthly life, to become more and more at My disposal.

Message of Nov. 27, 1994, from Our Lord Jesus

Jesus: The evil one will continue to come up against you, and tell you how foolish you are for doing these things for Me, but know in your heart that you are doing the will of God. Many who do the will of God, are considered foolish in a world that has turned away from Me and My desires. Continue to stand steadfast in your faith, and trust in your God. There is much more for you to do. As a chosen one, I know you will do it well. There are so few who wish to be of help to Me and My Mother. Know that all you do will be blessed one hundredfold. The struggles will continue for you, little one, but the reward for these struggles will be great. It's like the pot of gold at the end of the rainbow. Only your pot of gold will be Heaven, and all the glory that awaits you there.

Ruth Ann: We can handle our earthly struggles, Lord, as long as You hang in there with us.

Jesus: Little one, I am always here for you, and so is My Mother.

Ruth Ann: Lord, Your Mother said Her messages to share, soon will cease. Can You tell me why?

Jesus: Little one, My Mother has said and done all those things needed to get

things going here at the farm. She has done as She was told to do. She too, does the will of God, and it has been His will that She draw all His children to His Son and His word. She has continued to draw those who were receptive and humble to Her heart, and direct them to Her Son, so they would listen to what He has to say. As a good Mother, She has done the will of the Father, and called Her children out of darkness into the light. She has shared the words spoken by Her Son two thousand years ago, with all those who wish to listen.

The time is nearing for Her to leave Her children to their own resources. She has brought light, love, and peace to those who would listen. Those who have chosen to ignore what She has said, have missed many graces, and helps or blessings, that She was, and still is, allowed to pour out upon Her children. I love you. Go in peace to serve your God. We are pleased with your efforts, even though you may not be. God's love abounds, as does His grace and mercy, for all those who love Him, and struggle on this path to Calvary. Be at peace. It is your efforts and desires of your heart that are being measured.

Ruth Ann: Thank You, Lord for these words.

*Message of May 11, 1994,
from Our Lady*

Ruth Ann: Mother, I am full of sadness.

Our Lady: Yes, child, I know.

Ruth Ann: Even though we knew it had to be this way, and that it is the right thing to do, we will miss our horses.

Our Lady: Little child, you are not to be attached to anything of this earth.

Ruth Ann: I have been told this many times before. I've also been told that all my animals will eventually be removed from me. 'Thy will be

done'. My heart aches, but is this the will of God?

Our Lady: Yes, child, it is. Your life has changed. It is no longer your will, but God's will be done. You will experience pain, but you will also experience peace; peace at knowing you are always obedient to the will of God, no matter how painful. It is all part of following in the footsteps of My Son. It is all part of the cross. The pain purifies the soul and brings it to new heights never before experienced. You have spoken of peaks and valleys, child. These you will continue to experience.

Ruth Ann: I feel there are more valleys than peaks at this time of my life, Mother.

Our Lady: Are you sorry you have given your 'fiat'?

Ruth Ann: Not really sorry, but I'm not sure I am capable of doing all that God has expected of me.

Our Lady: Child, all of God's chosen instruments are capable. The graces are always there for those who choose to do the will of God. Man has a free will though, child, and he can choose to walk away from the work that God has in store for His children. Many choose to do so. You are not one of these. God knows your heart, and He knows you will persevere to the very end of your mission.

Ruth Ann: Then He knows something more than I do, Mother, because at times this all becomes almost too much to bear.

Our Lady: These are the times you must call upon your Mother. I am here whenever you have need of Me, remember. I have told you that before. My Jesus and your Jesus are here for you. Do not hesitate to share

those things that are burdening you. Your Jesus loves you, just as I do. We do not wish to have you suffer needlessly. Certain things must be done in your life in order to prepare you for what lies ahead. There is much more for you to do, and you must become detached from worldly things.

Your family is a gift from God. They will help you in your ministry. You do not understand what I am saying, but it is to be so. Ruth Ann: Thank You, Mother, for these words. I needed to hear those words. I was afraid God wanted them removed from me.

Our Lady: No, child, this is not part of God's plan. Be at peace with all that is and will be changing in your life. God's plan is perfect. Know you are loved and being cared for during this time. Be obedient to His will and be patient. All will unfold before you as God allows. It must be done in His time and in His way, child.

Ruth Ann: Yes, Mother, I realize it, but it is still difficult for me to wait, not knowing what is to come next. Much is happening that disturbs my peace.

Our Lady: Yes, child, I know to what you are referring. You were

forewarned, were you not?

Ruth Ann: Yes, Mother, I was, but it doesn't make it less difficult to handle.

Our Lady: Continue to pray, and know all things happen for the greater honor and glory of God. God's plan is perfect. His children need only be obedient and follow His will and not their own. That makes all things fall into place. It also brings with it, peace.

Ruth Ann: I love You, Mother.

Our Lady: I love you, My little daughter. Now I bless you in the Name of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. Go in the peace of My Son, Jesus Christ.

Ruth Ann: Thank You, Mother

Ruth Ann: Mother, we are living in such troubled times, that it is difficult to find peace, and keep it for very long. I am finding it extremely difficult.

you. This is called being molded. Remember, it is God Who does this molding, child. You are not in control. ‘Your will be done, Lord’. These words give God the right to do all He can to bring you into the light and love that awaits you.

It is not easy to follow the will of God, and turn away from the world. You must learn to accept all the crosses put before you, and know that He is in control, and all things are done for a reason. Trust, little children, trust that God's plan is perfect. No matter how many, and how heavy your crosses. They need not be carried alone. God is with you. I too, am here to assist you with graces and blessings in abundance. I, who am your Mother, wish to assist you in any way you need. Know I am praying with you, for all those things you voice, and those you hold in your heart.
